Judy Weisend said she has received positive feedback from those who have read the journal and had someone inquire about the website.

Brooke Yontz reported the Noble County Community Baby Shower will be held on April 26th from 6-8pm with outreach about not doing drugs while pregnant. If you would like to set up a booth please contact her.

Jody Parrish-Polen reported she watched a great documentary on TV recently and the message of help and information for help was great.

Dan Milleson reported he is running for state representative. Also noted he has a very close friend who was addicted to pills and heroin for 5-6years. He has now been clean for 3 years and is making 6 figures and supporting his family. He received help at uturnforchrist in Pennsylvania. He would like to come and speak at one of our upcoming meetings.

Jackie Knight from Crossroads Counseling in Woodsfield introduced herself as this was her first meeting.

Derek Norman reported he is excited for the Quick Response Team to get started. Also noted that the drug dog is doing very well and getting better every day. The dog was able to detect drugs used by 3 inmates a couple weeks ago. Also noted overdoses are down from previous numbers. The county did have an overdose last weekend though and it was a reported Heroin overdose however when the testing returned there was no heroin or meth found just fentanyl and car fentanyl.

Shari Rayner reported the Noble County Health Dept. is now providing services at the jail. Derek added that the Health Dept. staff is doing 10 times the amount of work that previous help had done.

Comments

Shawn Ray reported this group has made him more aware of things as his son recently had ACL surgery, was prescribed pain pills and now the anxiety of concern over addiction.

Roger Birch noted that Tammy Stillion is very afraid of dogs and worried about the Quick Response Team when making home visit. He was recently bitten by a dog so he added to her stress and sent her a pic of his bite.

Cindy Vansycoc shared they are working to start a rise and shine club and had positive feedback from a mom who has been sober for 5years and struggles to get up in the morning and get her children to school on time. This program will do an all-call in the morning and this mom expressed appreciation as nobody has ever helped her and her family.
